Area: 32 ha

Plant variety: 75% Merlot, 20% Cabernet Sauvignon, 5% Cabernet Franc

Average age of plants: 20 years

Soil: siliceo-gravelly

Location: North of Libourne on the territory of St Denis de Pile

Tasting: A ruby colour; fresh red fruit flavours (strawberry, raspberry) with crisp tannins

Best served with: red meat, roast chicken, ham or cold cuts.

Distinctions: the 2005 vintage was selected among the 100 best Bordeaux wines by the Gault et Millaux restaurant guide in 2008.
